



### Camp Director

Directing the camp is Baylor University Men's Golf Coach, Greg Priest who is in his 8th season as coach of the team. Coach Priest has led the Bears to 7 straight NCAA regional appearances which included a 25th place finish at the NCAA National Tournament in 2007. Before becoming head coach of Baylor, Greg Priest was an assistant at the University of Texas, Austin where he compiled three national top ten rankings. Prior to his stint at Texas, Priest spent two seasons (1998-2000) as head coach of both the men's and women's golf programs at Sam Houston State University. Priest led the Bearkats to consecutive third-place finishes in the Southland Conference in 1999 and 2000 and seven top-10 team finishes.

Camp staff will consist of the Baylor University Golf coaching staff, local PGA Professionals and Division I collegiate players, who serve as camp counselors. Golf instruction will focus on improving the camper's swing, short game, putting, and course management.

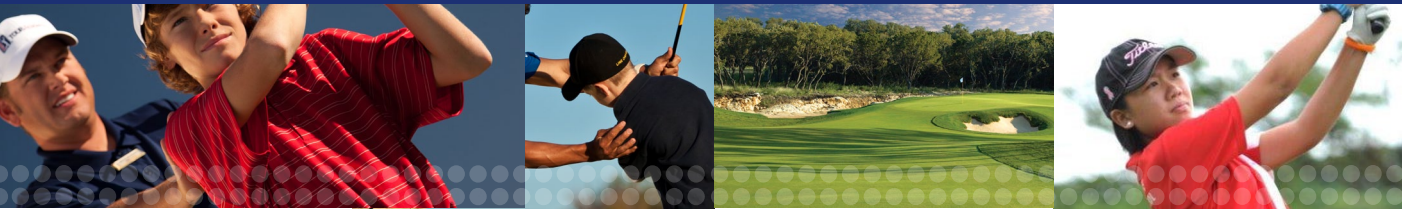

### Waco is the home of Baylor University and beautiful Twin Rivers Golf Club where all golf activities are hosted.

Junior Overnight Golf Camps – boys and girls, ages 10-18, all skill levels. Price includes all meals, accommodations, golf activities and a TOUR Academy camp amenity package.

Camp begins Sunday afternoon with registration/check in at the hotel. Registration is followed by campers being transported over to the golf facility for a couple hours of range instruction/course play and followed by player evaluation. Each student is evaluated that afternoon to ensure that we group the juniors of similar abilities together so that instruction can be specifically geared to each entry levelgolfer's. Each day thereafter, campers start the day early with breakfast and a camp meeting. Range instruction begins promptly and campers will rotate stations working on putting, chipping, pitching, bunker play and full swing. After lunch and short break, course play begins with staff on-course to help with club selection, shot selection and course management. To cap off the day, students will enjoy guest speakers, seminars, along with golf and non golf evening activities, such as movies, field games, swimming and night golf (evening activities may vary). Camp concludes on Thursday with a morning golf tournament followed by an afternoon departure. Instructor ratio of no more than 5:1.

#### Facilities/Accommodations

Twin Rivers Golf Club designed by Peter Jacobsen and Jim Hardy, Twin Rivers boasts a variety of features including elevation changes, dense wooded areas and several lakes and rivers. A central feature to the course and the camp is the Bailey Golf Center, the home of Baylor's men's and women's golf teams. The Bailey camp center houses an indoor practice area complete with state-of-the-art video equipment available for analyzing player's swings.

#### Accommodations

Campers will be housed two juniors per room in the newly remodeled Clarion Hotel Waco, located only a few miles from the Baylor University campus. Breakfast and dinner will be held at hotel dining facilities and lunch served at the golf course. Campers are fully supervised 24 hours a day by adult camp staff. Campers may also select roommates of his or her choice.

#### Camp Specifics

Campers will check-in on Sunday between 3:00 - 4:00 pm. The graduation ceremony will take place at the Clarion Hotel on Thursday at noon after the tournament at the Twin Rivers Golf Club.

#### Typical Daily Schedule:

- 7 a.m. Rise and shine, breakfast
- 8:00 a.m. Instructional skills demonstration at practice facility from staff focusing on key elements of the swing for that day
- 8:30 a.m. Instruction- campers rotate stations working on all aspects of the game
- 12:00 p.m. Lunch
- 1:00 p.m. Course play (9 to 18 holes daily). Staff to provide on course instruction and course management
- 6:00 p.m. Dinner
- 8:00 p.m. Evening activity (supervised golf and non-golf activities) movies, golf seminars, night golf, etc.
- 10:00 p.m. Lights out
